IMMIGRATION VETTING PROJECT: Houston Mayor's Race & Council

--- DEADLINE: Oct 3, 2011

A) Since Houston is the nation's hub for illegal human trafficking, Houstonians who are forced to pay the related costs for law enforcement and who are witnessing the victims of criminal activity, should have the right to vote on vetting Houston Police Department's present immigration policy. General Order (200-88). The enhancements in security should include the following:

- The elimination of Mexico's Matrícula Consular de Adu (requested as acceptable identification to verify identity and legal status)
- Increased access to federal databases to ascertain identity, not limited to just ICE (Federal Crime Information Center), but also the USBC, Law Enforcement Support Center databases
- Those detained by ICE and confirmed to be legally present in the US will be properly documented, fingerprinted, photographed and reported to the appropriate federal agencies

B) According to the FBI, legal alien street gangs such as MS-13 are arming themselves with high-powered military style weapons to violently engage in street encounters with law enforcement, rival gangs and the general public.
